

District Governor Checklist

Here are some specific tasks for you to consider in your District:

- Make Lions Quest your project for the year**
This is an opportune time to elevate the awareness and support of Lions Quest locally. In lieu of gifts for your official visit encourage Clubs to make a donation to Lions Quest.
- Choose your District Lions Quest Chair thoughtfully**
This person should be comfortable speaking with educators about the program, be capable of raising both awareness and funding from the clubs in the District, and be willing to participate at District events to promote the program.
- Host a special meeting of Cabinet to learn about Lions Quest**
This can be a casual get-together with the goal of ensuring that all Cabinet members are able to answer questions posed to them on their visitations and at other Lions functions.
- Encourage very club to include Lions Quest programs in their annual budget and to contact at least one school to discuss Lions Quest**
Include this item in your presentations to clubs, and at other communication opportunities.
- Participate in a Lions Quest workshop in your area**
Preferably attend the full workshop session, but at minimum visit the workshop to bring greetings from the Lions and show support for the District activity.
- Include information about Lions Quest in your District Newsletter**
Provide Lions Quest Canada with the name and email address of your editor to add to our mailing list for updates.
- Send a copy of your District Directory to Lions Quest Canada**
This will help us keep your team informed about Lions Quest in your area.
